Paper Lanterns

You will need: two sheets of colored paper, scissors, a pencil, a stapler, and a hole punch and string (optional).

1. Cut two one-inch strips down the long side of one of the sheets and set them aside.





- 2. Fold the second sheet of paper in half to form a long, skinny rectangle.
- 3. Draw pencil marks about two inches apart, as a guide, and cut along the lines with scissors, starting from the folded edge. Be sure not to cut all the way to the other edge of the paper - leave about an inch at the end.





- 4. Open up the paper and roll it to connect both ends. Staple the edges together.
- 5. Roll up the first sheet of paper and insert it into the lantern. Staple it into place.
- 6. Use the strips of paper you first cut off to decorate your lanterns, if desired.

Punch holes in the top and run a string through if you would like to hang your paper lanterns.
